tachi, mei: Kuniyuki (国行) (jūyō-tōken) shinogi-zukuri, nagasa 70,3 cm, sori 2,1 cm

There is a $b\bar{o}hi$ on both sides which ends with a kaku-dome in the tang. In this hi, on both sides, the bonji for "baumu" is engraved which stands for the deity Dainichi-Nyorai (大日如来). The jigane is an itame and the hamon a suguha mixed with ko-gunome with plentiful of ko-nie and many ashi and $y\bar{o}$. The yakiba is especially flamboyant from the mid blade section down to the base. A beautiful and magnificent zaimei-tachi of Rai Kuniyoshi. (Owner: Mikami Noboru, 三上登)
